Memphis, Saqqara, and Dahshur Wheelchair Accessible Tours

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet you anywhere in Cairo or Giza for a private wheelchair-accessible tour of Memphis, Saqqara, and Dahshur Pyramids. Begin your journey at the Step Pyramid in Saqqara, renowned as the largest and oldest stone structure worldwide, built during the 3rd dynasty for King Djoser, a significant ruler in Egypt's history.

Next, proceed to Memphis, founded by King Menes, the pioneer of Egypt's dynastic history by uniting Upper and Lower Egypt during the 1st dynasty. Memphis served as the capital during the Old Kingdom and a cultural hub for over 3000 years. Here, you'll encounter the statue of King Ramses II, a prominent figure in the New Kingdom, and the Alabaster Sphinx of Memphis.

Continue to Dahshur, where although some pyramids have succumbed to time and the elements, it houses two of Egypt's earliest pyramids. Built under the reign of King Sneferu, founder of the 4th dynasty and father of King Cheops, these include the Bent Pyramid and the Red Pyramid. These structures showcase the architectural evolution leading to the construction of the Great Pyramids in Giza.
