<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrive Cairo

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, you will be greeted by our representative who will escort you to your hotel in Giza or Cairo in a private air-conditioned vehicle, ensuring a seamless check-in process.

Enjoy the evening at your leisure, with the opportunity to explore our range of activities and tours in Cairo that will be discussed with you after your Egypt 14-Day Tour itinerary review.

Welcome Drink.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tours - Saqqara Necropolis - Memphis City

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel, your day begins with your tour guide meeting you in the morning for an exciting Cairo day tour to the Giza Pyramids.

Stand at the base of these ancient structures, dating back 4500 years, and journey through Egypt's illustrious history as your guide recounts tales from this golden era. Behold the three pyramids constructed for the kings Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus of the Old Kingdom, serving as their eternal resting places and portals to the afterlife.

You'll also see the smaller pyramids built for the queens near King Cheops' Great Pyramid, then ascend to the high Giza Plateau for breathtaking views and photo opportunities, with the option to ride camels guided by your tour guide or local Bedouins.

Next, explore the pyramid complex of King Chephren, including the iconic Great Sphinx—a mythical lion with a human head symbolizing the Pharaoh's power and wisdom. Enter the Valley Temple where the king's mummification took place as part of ancient funeral rituals.

Continue your journey to the Saggara Necropolis, a short drive from Giza Pyramids, to marvel at the

Step Pyramid, the earliest stone pyramid built by the renowned architect Imhotep for King Djoser's burial. Wander through the Hep-Sed court and explore the pyramid of King Teti, which you can enter to admire well-preserved inscriptions and the tomb of the noble Kagemni, who served as vizier of justice under King Teti.

Enjoy lunch at a reputable restaurant before visiting Memphis, Egypt's ancient capital where you'll explore the open-air museum and be awed by the colossal statues of King Ramses II and the alabaster sphinx.

Return to your hotel for leisure time and relaxation for the remainder of the day.

Day 3: Cairo City Tour - Egyptian Museum - Islamic Cairo Tour

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel and meet your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide who will lead you on an immersive Cairo city tour. Your exploration begins at the Egyptian Museum, a historic monument over a century old, where you'll have ample time to marvel at ancient artifacts and monuments.

The highlight is the dazzling collection of treasures from King Tutankhamun, among the museum's most fascinating exhibits.

Travel in your private vehicle to the Citadel of Saladin, erected by the renowned Muslim leader Sultan Saladin to fortify Cairo. Explore the impressive Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali at the citadel's summit, and discover the city's oldest mosques during your Islamic Cairo tour.

Afterwards, enjoy lunch and return to your hotel.

Day 4: Bahariya Oasis Tour from Cairo

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and embark on an exciting 3-day Bahariya Oasis tour and White Desert Safari from Cairo. Experience the stunning landscapes of the western deserts, including the lush date palm groves of Bahriya Oasis. Explore the Valley of Golden Mummies, where around thirty-four tombs have been unearthed so far, along with the Tombs of the Nobles.

Feel the thrill as you journey through the Black Desert in a land cruiser, formed by a volcanic eruption over 1600 million years ago. Visit the Crystal Mountain and the Valley of Agabat before camping overnight in the White Desert.

Travel to Bahriya Oasis in a modern air-conditioned vehicle, approximately a 4-hour drive from Cairo. Upon arrival, visit the Museum of Golden Mummies, a significant burial site in the Western Desert where over ten thousand mummies have been discovered. Explore the Tombs of the Nobles and the temple dedicated to Alexander the Great, the only known temple in Egypt built during his lifetime, dedicated to Amun Ra and Horus, along with the Temple of Meftella.

Enjoy a local lunch and have leisure time in the afternoon at your hotel. Experience a breathtaking sunset panoramic view of the oasis from atop the Black Mountain during a land cruiser excursion.

Day 5: The White Desert and Black Desert Tour

After an early morning breakfast at the hotel, meet your guide who will lead you on a journey to explore the natural wonders of the Bahariya Oasis. Begin with visits to the salt lake and golden sand dunes, surrounded by lush date palm groves which are iconic to the oasis.

Next, venture towards the White Desert, passing through the unique Black Desert characterized by volcano-shaped mountains and abundant small black stones. Along the way, stop to admire the quartz crystal formations at Crystal Mountain and the breathtaking views of the Valley of Agabat.

Experience an unforgettable camping experience in the White Desert and delight in watching the sunset before enjoying a delicious dinner.

Day 6: Bahariya Oasis and White Desert Tour Back to Cairo

Today marks the final day of your White Desert excursion from Cairo! Start your day with breakfast amidst the stunning landscape of the White Desert. Afterwards, visit the hot water springs and capture photos of the mesmerising white limestone formations known as the Mushrooms, the tree, the chicken, the sphinx, the tents, and the rabbit.

Return to Bahariya Oasis and prepare for your journey back to Cairo, where our representative will accompany you in an air-conditioned vehicle to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 7: Siwa Oasis from Cairo

After resting following your adventurous tour of Bahariya Oasis and the White Desert, prepare for the next leg of your journey—a trip to Siwa Oasis from Cairo. Your Egyptologist tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo or Giza at 06:00 am for the Siwa Desert Safari, renowned as one of the most enchanting places in Egypt's Western Desert.

You'll travel to Siwa Oasis via the El-Alamein road, with your first stop at El Alamein to visit the World War II museum and walk among the cemeteries dedicated to those who fought in the war. In 1942, Allied forces led by Britain's Field Marshal Montgomery successfully halted the German-Italian advance towards the River Nile, marking a significant victory albeit with considerable casualties—11,000 killed and 60,000 wounded.

Your personal guide and driver will escort you to the Commonwealth World War II Cemetery, where 7,000 white headstones honor Australian, New Zealand, and British soldiers. Explore the site of the

battle and visit the war museum to learn more about its history.

Following this, you'll drive along the picturesque bay of Marsa Matrouh on the Mediterranean coast, where you'll enjoy a delicious seafood lunch. Afterward, continue your journey to Siwa Oasis, approximately 4 hours drive from Marsa Matrouh.

Upon arrival in Siwa, dine overnight at a charming eco-lodge.

Day 8: Siwa Sightseeing

Breakfast in the Eco-lodge then you will continue your Siwa Oasis tour from Cairo, enjoying visiting the ruins of the Old Town of Shali.

After that, you will be transferred to see the Temple of Alexander the Great (the temple of The Oracle) at the Aghurmi village dates back to the 26th dynasty, and visit the temple of Amun Ra known as the Temple of Um Ubeyda, then experience the unique Siwan heritage through the Siwa House Museum and lunch will be served in the Oasis famous square overlooking Shali at Abdo restaurant you will also visit the Mountain of the Dead (Jabal el Mawta) visit the interesting tombs of the rulers of Siwa Oasis during the 26th dynasty like the tombs of SI Amon, MSW Isis, crocodile tomb, then you will enjoy relaxing afternoon at Cleopatra Spring (Ein Guba) swimming and dipping into the sparkling water after that you will be transferred Fitnas Island to enjoy once in the lifetime Sunset view.

Overnight in Siwa.

Day 9: Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

Enjoy a wholesome breakfast at the hotel, followed by the continuation of your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari adventure. On the second day, your guide will take you on a four-wheel drive to explore the vast Great Sand Sea.

Embark on an Egypt Desert Safari amidst golden sand dunes, reaching the fossils area where ancient rocky coral reefs from the Cambrian era are visible. Discover one of the highlights of the Great Sand Sea—a picturesque lake nestled in the desert. With luck, you may spot flamingo birds and have the opportunity to swim in the lake's cool waters, enjoying the peaceful desert surroundings and a relaxing atmosphere.

Next, pass by Dakrour Mountain and experience sandboarding—an exhilarating activity down massive sand dunes. While not as fast as snowboarding, with the right preparation, you can enjoy thrilling descents. After sandboarding, unwind at Bir Wahid hot spring renowned for its soothing effects on muscles.

Witness another breathtaking sunset amidst the dunes of the Great Sand Sea, savoring Bedouin tea in this tranquil setting.

Day 10: Back to Cairo

On the final day of our Siwa Oasis tour package, enjoy breakfast at the Eco-lodge before your transfer back to your hotel in Cairo. Start your journey to Alexandria, known as the Bride of the Mediterranean for its natural beauty and rich cultural history. Founded by Alexander the Great in 332 B.C., it remains a top attraction in Egypt.

Travel in a modern air-conditioned vehicle for approximately 2 hours, with a stop along the way for refreshments, restroom breaks, or stretching your legs.

Begin your Alexandria tour by visiting Pompey's Pillar, the lone column from the Roman temple amidst the ruins of the Serapeum. Continue to the medieval Citadel of Qaitbay, built on the site of the ancient lighthouse, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world.

Explore the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, a complex of tombs and chambers dating back to Roman times, showcasing richly decorated burials of a Romanized Egyptian family.

Next, visit the Bibliotheca of Alexandria, originally founded in the 3rd century BC by Ptolemy I and expanded by Ptolemy II. Although its collections were lost over time due to changes in power and invasions, it remains a significant cultural site.

Drive along the corniche and visit the old harbor to observe traditional fishing activities, providing picturesque photo opportunities.

Conclude your tour with a gourmet lunch at a high-quality restaurant. Return to Cairo with a break on the way back after a memorable day exploring Alexandria.
