Day 1 - Cairo to the white desert

At the break of dawn, your tour guide will be present at your hotel in Cairo and drive you in a contemporary, luxuriously air-conditioned car towards the White Desert. We'll make our way to Bahariya Oasis, which is situated about 350 km west of Cairo with two coffee breaks in between. The major of Bahariya County, located on the western desert of Egypt, is used as the country's largest producer of iron ore.

After your arrival at the Bahariya Oasis, your safari guide will meet you, and you will get on a 4x4 Jeep, which is known to drive well. The first place to visit is the Black Desert, a place where mountains, highlands, and dunes are all covered with black powder. After that, we will make our way to El Haize Oasis, which is a distance of 37 km from Bawiti, where lunch will be served, and after that, relax in a hot spring.

Then we will head over to the Valley of Agabat, which is one of those beautiful places that are rich in both natural and historical resources. After all, this valley is quite picturesque, but unfortunately, the white heat of sandstorms has coated everything in white sand. But last, savor the amazing views of the desert sunset from the comfort of your tent and enjoy another round of sumptuous meals.

Day 2 - djara cave , the Ain El-Serw Spring

In the morning, there are already arrangements for you to see the sunrise in the desert, as well as breakfast that will follow. Thereafter, we will head out to Djara Cave, located in the far western desert and regarded as one of the finest prehistoric sites. This astonishing cave has bedrock structures that defy the norm and has the only remaining undamaged pictures of leaping gazelles and other wildlife within a range of 250 kilometers. The beauty of the cave is augmented by a delicate dripstone formed by years of crystalline structures.

Next, we go towards Ain El-Sera Spring, through another cognomen of Egypt called the medicinal springs. The Ain El-Sera consists of medicinal spring waters situated in the El-Gabal area of the Cairo Governorate. It already became a center for a rejuvenating retreat ages ago. It is reputedly relaxing to both the body and the mind, and it has high mineral content that helps with healthful concerns. Tourists can go to the clean, refreshing water spring, thus making the spring a suitable place for picnics.

After which, you will be enjoying a nice lunch in the prudent Sera desert with beautiful views of the surroundings. As you close the day, you will witness beautiful views of the sunset, a marvelous view of the stars and the moon at night, and finish with dinner at your camp.

Day 3 - explore , bahariya oasis

After finishing breakfast, we will go to the Bahariya Oasis, but not before taking a detour to the Crystal Mountain, also referred to as Jabal Al Azzaz. The crystalline mountain, which is actually composed of quartzite crystal deposits, is desired to be called the desert's diamond since it is quite impressive when sunlight shines over it. Its existence came to be known about only a few decades

ago, by pure chance.

After this, we will proceed to the Bahariya, relaxing and recharging for our itineraries in one of the most beautiful and secluded places in this world. Within a western desert of Egypt, this jewel is famous for how serene and beautiful it is. Numerous coconut trees, date trees, and acacia trees adorn the scenery, and the smell of their sweet flowers, that of jasmine and orange, fills the place. There are also animals in the oasis, such as deer, ibex, and oryx.

You will still have lunch after you have checked in your hotel and then will start to explore the oasis of Bahariya. You will have an excursion to Gebel Maghrafa, the palm and olive farms, and Bahariya Oasis itself. It is particularly interesting because in 1914 at the base of Gebel Dist were unearthed the remains of the greatest Diansour (certainly the ages of Stromer's Tidal Giant). And also, the biggest salt lake in Bahariya Oasis, Lake al-Marun, is picturesque too.

To conclude this long and eventful day, it is possible to go up English Mountain (Gebel Al Ingleez) to be enchanted by the stunning view, which includes the entire northern part of the oasis, and watch the sunset. Lastly, we will go back to the hotel to wind up the day.

Day 4 -Baharyia oasis- Cairo

After breakfast, we will move on to Bawiti, which is the principal town of Bahariya Oasis, situated in Egypt's Western Desert, about 350 km (217 miles) out of Cairo. Bahariya Oasis has to be remembered as the biggest in extent in the context of the Western Desert and among the busiest ones too, boasting almost 30, 000 people as its occupants.

Subsequently, we are going to proceed toward the Ain El Muftella shrine in addition to the Museum of the Golden Mummies that is located in Bahariya Oasis. After having lunch in the area, we will return to Cairo.
