<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrive Cairo International Airport

Your tour guide will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> upon arrival and will be transferred to your Cairo hotel for check-in. You will be welcomed with a drink and help you revise your 11 Days Egypt luxury tour itinerary with our representative.

Overnight at your Cairo hotel.

Day 2: Pyramids and Cairo Tours

Your tour guide will be waiting for you at the hotel after you have had breakfast to begin your Egypt Tours. First, we'll explore the Giza Pyramids Necropolis area, where you'll learn about the Great Pyramid of Cheops - one of the ancient seven wonders of the world. Next, we'll go to the <u>Great Sphinx of Giza</u> - a magnificent sculpture cut in the shape of a lion's body and a human head, representing power and knowledge.

If you're looking for a memorable way to experience Cairo, consider taking a camel ride to get a bird's eye view of the Giza Plateau. This adventure will allow you to capture all the beauty and history of this amazing city.

The Egyptian Museum in Cairo is a great place to visit for anyone interested in ancient artifacts. The museum has a magnificent collection of artifacts from the earliest days of human history, including the golden King Tutankhamun. After lunch, you'll take a fascinating local Coptic Cairo tour, which will show you some of the earliest churches in Coptic history. You'll see the Abu Serga Church and the Hanging Church, as well as the Jewish Ben Ezra Synagogue. This tour will be a real enrichment for your visit to Egypt, and you'll be able to appreciate the history and culture of this fascinating country in a whole new way.

After finishing the trip to Cairo, you will be transported back to your hotel.

Day 3: White Desert Tour

After breakfast, you and your personal guide will go to the White Desert, which is one of the newly declared protectorates of Egypt. The White Desert has a truly magical effect on its visitors, and it is located entirely in the Farafra region.

The Black Desert is one of the most popular tourist destinations in <u>Egypt Desert Safari adventure</u>, as the mountains have been slowly eroding to cover the desert with a layer of dust and black rocks. This is why it's known as the Black Desert.

You'll be able to explore the English mountain, the highest point in the Black Desert, to enjoy beautiful views of its unique landscape and the Valley of El Haize, located near the western end of Bahariya Oasis.

You'll have a chance to visit some beautiful landscapes at Crystal Mountain and the Great Valley of Agabat, as well as camp in the White Desert.

Dinner is served after sunset.

Day 4: Bahariya Oasis Tour

In the morning, after breakfast, you will enjoy a hot water spring and take some beautiful photos of the fascinating white formations from limestone cliffs, like the one with the shape of the mushroom and the rabbit. Then, you will be transferred to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> to be transferred to Cairo hotel.

Overnight in Cairo

Day 5: Cairo to Aswan - Aswan Sightseeing Tours

After breakfast, we'll transfer you to Cairo International Airport to take your domestic flight to Aswan. Upon arrival at Aswan Airport, you'll start your tour of our <u>Aswan day tours</u> by visiting the Aswan High Dam, which was built in 1960 to save Egypt from the floods that occur every year. Then visit <u>Philae</u> <u>Temple</u> to see its amazing stones and inscriptions have been preserved for thousands of years to tell us how strong and advanced our ancestors were.

At the end of your trip, you will be transferred to your hotel for check-in and overnight after the Aswan day tours are completed.

Day 6: Edfu Temple - Overnight in Luxor

Your breakfast will be served at your hotel in Aswan before checking out to start your visit to the Temple of Edfu dedicated to the worship of the falcon God Horus. Then you will be transfered to your hotel in Luxor to overnight there.

Day 7: Karnak Temple - Luxor Museum

Following breakfast, commence your tour with Luxor East Bank tours. The Luxor Temple, situated on

the east bank of the Nile River, is one of the largest and most ancient Egyptian temples. Initially built by Amenhotep III of the 18th Dynasty, it was later completed by Ramses II of the 19th Dynasty.

You'll also visit the Luxor Museum, housing artifacts from King Tutankhamun's tomb and a collection of 26 statues from the New Kingdom, unearthed in the Luxor statue cache near Luxor Temple in 1989. Enjoy an overnight stay in Luxor.

Day 8: Luxor West Bank Tours

Start your day by visiting the Colossi of Memnon, two impressive statues depicting Amenhotep III. Next, explore the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, known as El Deir El Bahri, carved into the mountainside and commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut in the 15th century B.C. This temple served as her mortuary temple.

Proceed to the Valley of the Kings, where more than 62 tombs were built by kings of the New Kingdom, beginning with Tutmosis of the 18th dynasty and continuing through the 19th and 20th dynasties. The Valley of the Kings gained fame following the discovery of King Tutankhamun's tomb.

Afterwards, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Hurghada for an overnight stay.

Day 9: Free Day in Hurghada

After a relaxed breakfast at your hotel in Hurghada, you'll have the day to explore the attractions and atmosphere of Hurghada at your leisure. You can also select from our range of optional tours or enjoy your own activities at your own pace.

Day 10: Hurghada - Back to Cairo

After breakfast at your hotel in Hurghada, you will be transferred to Hurghada Airport for your flight to Cairo International Airport, where you will have the rest of the day at your leisure.
