Day 1: Cairo, Nile and Lake Nasser Cruise Luxury Trip

Upon your arrival at the airport in Cairo, you will be welcomed by one of the city's top tour representatives. They will assist you with the check-in process and transfer you to your hotel in a private, air-conditioned vehicle driven by your driver.

At the hotel, your tour leader will be present to help you with the check-in and go over the itinerary for your Egypt Luxury Tours. They will also confirm the scheduled pick-up times for each tour activity.

You will be spending the night in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / The Egyptian museum Trip

Start your day with a delightful breakfast, fueling up for the adventures ahead. Your private guide will meet you in your hotel lobby, ready to lead you to the iconic Giza Plateau. Here, you'll marvel at the remarkable achievements of the ancient Egyptian pharaohs, standing before the awe-inspiring Great Pyramid of King Cheops, the largest structure ever constructed in human history, along with the smaller but equally significant pyramids of his son, Chephren, and grandson, Mycerinus.

Your expert Egyptologist will unravel the fascinating lives of these rulers, sharing insights into their prosperous reigns and explaining why they built such magnificent structures as their final resting places. As you stand on the high plateau, you'll be treated to a panoramic view of all three pyramids. For an extra touch of adventure, you may opt for a scenic camel ride, with a friendly Bedouin guide helping you capture breathtaking photos against the timeless backdrop of these ancient wonders.

Guarding these treasures is the enigmatic Sphinx, a symbol of royal power and protection. Next, you'll visit the Valley Temple of King Chephren, where the ancient mummification rituals took place before the Pharaoh's burial. The temple, built from massive red granite blocks from Aswan and paved with alabaster, is an architectural marvel that leaves visitors in awe of its craftsmanship.

From here, you'll head to Cairo's bustling downtown for a visit to the world-renowned Egyptian Museum. Inside, you'll explore a vast collection of ancient artefacts, including the priceless golden treasures of King Tutankhamun, unearthed by Howard Carter in 1922. Take your time to absorb the rich history on display before heading off to the next chapter of your tour.

Afterwards, indulge in a delicious lunch at a stylish restaurant before continuing to Coptic Cairo, where history unfolds before your eyes. Explore the remnants of the Roman fortress of Babylon, built in the 1st century, and discover some of Egypt's most fascinating churches. The Hanging Church, perched above ancient fortress towers, and the Church of St. Sergius, built over a cavern where the

Holy Family is believed to have sought refuge, will leave a lasting impression. You'll also visit Ben Ezra Synagogue, where tradition holds that the Pharaoh's daughter discovered baby Moses in a basket along the Nile.

Your journey then takes you into the heart of Islamic Cairo, where you'll stroll through the medieval streets, passing by the ancient gates and walls that date back to the Fatimid era of the 10th century. As the tour winds down, you'll relax with a refreshing cup of mint tea at the famous Fishawy Café in Khan El Khalili Bazaar, one of the city's oldest markets. Here, you can browse for unique souvenirs, preserving the memory of your incredible Egyptian adventure.

If time permits, consider capping off the day with an optional Sound and Light Show at the Giza Pyramids—a dazzling spectacle that will leave you spellbound as the ancient stones come to life with colour and history.

Day 3: Luxor/ Nile Cruise

On your third day, you'll start the day with an early morning transfer to Luxor. Your tour leader will escort you to Cairo International Airport, where you'll catch a flight to Luxor, the city famously known as the "world's greatest open-air museum" and the heart of Egypt's ancient history. Upon landing at Luxor International Airport, you'll be warmly greeted by our representative and transported to your accommodation aboard the luxurious 5-star Movenpick MS Royal Lily or a similar Nile cruise ship.

After settling in and enjoying a delicious lunch on board, you'll embark on an unforgettable East Bank tour of Luxor. Your first stop will be the impressive Karnak Temple, an awe-inspiring religious complex dedicated to the Theban Triad, where ancient pharaohs built upon the site for over 2,000 years. Walk through the towering columns and expansive courtyards, marvelling at the scale and grandeur of this ancient wonder.

Next, you'll take a stroll down the Avenue of Sphinxes, a breathtaking pathway once lined with hundreds of these mythical creatures, leading you to the majestic Luxor Temple. This site was built around 1400 BC and once served as a major centre for the worship of the god Amun. You'll have the chance to explore the beautifully preserved statues, columns, and courtyards that transport you back to Egypt's golden era.

As the evening sets in, you'll return to your cruise for a delightful dinner served on board, where you can unwind and reflect on the day's incredible sights.

For an added treat, you may choose to book an optional sound and light show at Karnak Temple. This captivating experience brings the ancient complex to life with a vivid display of lights and dramatic narration, immersing you in the history and legends of Egypt's ancient gods and kings.

Day 4: West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu

After enjoying breakfast on your Nile cruise boat, you will have the opportunity to discover the Colossi of Memnon - two awe-inspiring ancient Egyptian statues that are the sole remnants of a once-magnificent temple.

Next, you will explore the Valley of the Kings, where over 62 pharaohs from the New Kingdom, including King Tutankhamun and the victorious Ramses II, were buried. The tombs, chiselled into the mountain, feature enchanting paintings and are filled with treasures that once belonged to Egypt's royal pharaohs.

Your tour will continue at the Temple of Hatshepsut, also known as the Temple of Deir El Bahari. This complex of ancient Egyptian temples, located on the west bank of the Nile River near Luxor (ancient Thebes), was built by Egypt's first female ruler, who reigned for 20 prosperous years.

After completing the Luxor West Bank Tours, you will be served lunch before embarking on a cruise to Edfu. During the cruise, you can enjoy dinner and entertainment on the boat. Additionally, if you desire, you can opt for a Luxor Hot Air Balloon ride (an optional activity).

You will spend the night on your Nile cruise.

Day 5: The temples of Edfu / Kom Ombo

After a delicious breakfast aboard your Nile cruise, your day begins with a visit to the Temple of Edfu. This magnificent temple, dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god of kingship and protection, is one of Egypt's best-preserved ancient sites, offering a fascinating glimpse into the sacred rituals and royal power of ancient Egypt.

Following your exploration of Edfu, you will travel to the Temple of Kom Ombo. Day 7: Aswan/ Abu Simbel/ Lake Cruise prepare

Day 8: Kasr Ibrim

Begin your day with breakfast as you continue your cruise towards Qasr Ibrim, the sole remnant of the Nile's ancient floodplain. This historic site, which once served as a significant frontier fort during the Roman era, offers a glimpse into its past as a pivotal center for Nubian tribes until their conversion to Christianity in the 6th century.

From the sun deck, you'll embark on a tour to the Amada archaeological site. Here, you can enjoy lunch while cruising to your next destination.

Your exploration includes visits to the Amada and Derr temples, as well as the tomb of Pinout, promising a memorable experience rich in history and culture.

In the afternoon, you'll continue your leisurely cruise towards Wadi El Seboua. After a day of exploration, savor a delicious dinner on board and relax with an overnight stay on the ship.

Day 9:Temple of Dekka

On the ninth day of your journey, you'll explore the Temple of Wadi El Seboua, renowned for its impressive lion statues. Following this, you'll visit the temples of Dakka and Moharraka, located in Lower Nubia.

Day 10: Disembark - Back to Cairo

Next, you'll visit the Beit El Wali Temple, which was relocated and preserved by Germany to prevent it from being submerged. This temple, dedicated to Amun Ra, and the Kiosk of Kertassi offer a

fascinating glimpse into ancient Nubian heritage.

Following your explorations, you'll be taken to Aswan Airport for your flight back to Cairo.

When you arrive in Cairo, a representative will help you with your transfer to the hotel.

Pompey's Pillar: This iconic column, with debated origins, stands as a powerful symbol of Alexandria's past grandeur, possibly dedicated to the Roman general Pompey or as a testament to the city's might.

Citadel of Qaitbay: An essential fortress built by Sultan Qaitbay in the 15th century, this fortification reflects the strength and historical significance of the Qaitbay dynasty along the Mediterranean coast.

Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa: These extensive Roman-era burial chambers are the largest in Egypt and offer a glimpse into the burial practices and historical significance of the area.

Bibliotheca Alexandrina: A modern tribute to the ancient Library of Alexandria, this architectural marvel serves as a centre for knowledge and research, echoing the scholarly spirit of its predecessor.

You'll drive along Al Bahr Street, enjoying views of Alexandria's picturesque skyline and the Stanley Bridge before returning to Cairo for the evening.
