Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

As soon as you arrive at Cairo International Airport, you'll be warmly greeted by a professional tour leader ready to assist you. From there, your driver will escort you in a private, air-conditioned vehicle, ensuring a seamless and comfortable transfer to your hotel.

Upon arrival at the hotel, our representative will swiftly handle your check-in process, making sure everything is taken care of without any hassle. They'll also go over your Egypt Tour Packages itinerary with you, ensuring all pick-up times are confirmed for the duration of your stay.

Afterwards, you can unwind and enjoy a restful night in the comfort of your hotel, ready to embark on your adventures in Egypt the following day.

Day 2: Pyramids Tour

You'll begin your day with a delicious breakfast at your hotel, setting the tone for an exciting adventure with our Cairo Day Tours in Egypt. Afterward, you'll meet your expert tour guide, who will lead you on a fascinating journey to the iconic Great Pyramid of Cheops, standing tall at 146 meters. You'll also visit the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, and marvel at the awe-inspiring Great Sphinx and the Valley Temple on the Giza Plateau, a site famous for its breathtaking pyramid tours. During your visit, we'll take a panoramic tour of the Giza pyramids, offering the perfect opportunity to capture stunning photos as a part of your Cairo itinerary.

After enjoying a satisfying lunch, the journey continues to Saqqara, where you'll discover the Step Pyramid Complex, including the world's first stone structure, the Djoser Step Pyramid. The tour will also grant you access to the pyramid of Teti, known for its intricate and beautifully preserved interior. Additionally, you'll have the chance to explore one of the noble tombs at Saqqara, where vibrant carvings and paintings on the walls and corridors depict scenes of daily life in ancient Egypt, offering you a glimpse into the past.

The day's adventure continues in Memphis, the once-thriving capital of the ancient pharaohs, located just a 30-minute drive south of Giza. Now known as Mit Rahina, Memphis was a hub of religion and culture for centuries. Here, you'll visit the open-air museum, which is home to the impressive alabaster sphinx, the second-largest in Egypt, carved from an 80-ton block of marble. You'll also come face-to-face with the colossal statue of King Ramses II, a truly remarkable sight.

After an enriching day of exploration, you'll return to your hotel in Cairo for a relaxing overnight stay. If you're up for more adventure, you have the option to enjoy the spectacular Sound and Light Show at Giza, which brings the history of the pyramids to life in a captivating display.

Day 3: Cairo Tours

After enjoying your breakfast at the hotel, you'll be accompanied by a professional tour guide to explore the wonders of the Egyptian Museum in Cairo. This museum houses the largest and most valuable collection of ancient Egyptian artefacts in the world. One of the most captivating exhibits is the collection that belonged to the famous pharaoh, Tutankhamun, whose tomb was discovered by the renowned British archaeologist, Howard Carter, in 1922.

Next, you'll be escorted to the Citadel of Saladin, a 12th-century fortress that helped strengthen Cairo as the capital of Egypt. You'll then visit the renowned alabaster mosque, built by Mohamed Ali in 1805, and take in the picturesque panorama of Islamic Cairo, with its centuries-old mosques, minarets, and domes.

Your tour will continue in Coptic Cairo, where you'll explore the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church built above the fortress towers, and the Cavern Church, where the holy family is said to have stayed. You'll also visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue, believed to be the site where the Pharaoh's daughter found the basket of the prophet Moses in the Nile.

Your tour manager will then guide you through the Islamic Cairo district, where you'll be amazed by the walls, gates, and ancient streets and corners dating back to the 10th century. You'll have the opportunity to walk to the famous Khan El Khalili market, where you can savour delicious mint tea at the Al-Fishawy cafe and enjoy a wonderful shopping experience.

As an optional activity, you can attend the sound and light show at the Giza Pyramids in the evening.

Day 04: Cairo to Aswan tour

After breakfast, you'll be taken to Cairo International Airport for a domestic flight to Aswan. Upon arrival, your guide will meet you and assist with boarding your Nile cruise ship.

Once on board, you'll enjoy a scenic sail on a traditional Felucca boat, exploring Kitchener's Island and visiting the Aga Khan Mausoleum.

Back on the cruise ship, you'll have the chance to relax with afternoon tea on the upper deck. In the evening, enjoy a delicious dinner while being entertained by a Nubian Folkloric show, marking your first night on the Nile.
