Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, our experienced tour guide will collect your luggage from the baggage claim area and transport you to your Cairo hotel in a private air-conditioned vehicle.

Upon arrival at the hotel, you will be greeted with a welcome drink. Your tour guide will then assist you with the check-in process and review the itinerary for your 13-day luxury tour to ensure that pickup times for each day of your Egypt day tours are confirmed.

Overnight accommodation in Cairo is included.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Khan El Khalili

Enjoy a hearty breakfast at your hotel before embarking on your Giza tour, ensuring you're energised to explore the Giza Plateau and the iconic Pyramids of Cheops. Throughout the tour, your knowledgeable guide will accompany you, ensuring an exceptional experience.

Behind these majestic pyramids lie the remnants of Chephren's son and grandson, as well as the Great Sphinx, commissioned by Chephren to guard his necropolis. Concluding your Giza Pyramids tour, you'll visit the sole surviving Valley Temple from Chephren's pyramid complex.

Next, immerse yourself in an unforgettable Coptic Cairo tour, where you'll visit the Hanging Church, St. Sergius Church (Abu Serga), and Ben Ezra Synagogue—all situated in Cairo's oldest neighbourhood.

After lunch, take a leisurely break before continuing your Cairo day tours with a visit to the Egyptian Museum. Finally, explore one of Cairo's ancient souks, Khan el Khalili, on a unique walking tour. At day's end, you'll be transferred back to your hotel.

Overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 3: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

After enjoying breakfast around 6 a.m., you will check out to commence your Egypt Desert Safari adventure. Our tour guide will meet you and accompany you in a modern, air-conditioned vehicle to Bahariya Oasis, a journey of approximately four hours from Cairo.

Upon arrival, our first stops will include the Museum of Golden Mummies, the Tombs of the Nobles where ancient oasis rulers were buried, the Temple of Alexander the Great in Bahariya Oasis, who founded the illustrious city of Alexandria, and the Temple of Muftella, dedicated to the deity Bis, revered in ancient Egypt.

Lunch will be served at a Bedouin-style restaurant. Following lunch, we will proceed to the hotel for check-in, and you will have the afternoon free to relax.

Before sunset, you will ascend the Black Mountain to explore the ruins atop the mountain, including "the English House," and enjoy the scenic views of Bahariya Oasis at sunset.

Overnight stay in Bahariya.

Day 4: White Desert and Black Desert

After breakfast in the morning, you'll visit the stunning salt lake to admire the views and capture memorable photographs. Experience the majestic golden sand dunes and learn local techniques for climbing palm trees.

Our journey to the White Desert begins with a visit to the Black Desert, known for its volcanic mountains adorned with vast quantities of volcanic rocks. Following that, we'll explore the Valley of El

Haize, located south of Bawiti and Bahariya.

We'll pause to observe the quartz crystal formations in the Crystal Mountain area and then spend some time in the picturesque Valley of Agabat before setting up camp in the White Desert amidst its captivating white limestone and chalk formations.

Enjoy a traditional Bedouin dinner in the desert.

Day 5: Farafra and Dakhla Oases

Enjoy a traditional morning tea with mint, prepared by locals, during breakfast. Following this, we will journey to the Farafra Oasis, where you can relax in the soothing sulfur-hot water spring of Bir Setah, also known as Setah Well.

During your visit to Farafra, you'll have the opportunity to explore the unique mud brick museum of local artist Badr and stroll through the historic town of Al Qasr. From Farafra, we will drive approximately three hours to Dakhla, where you will visit the Roman Temple of Deir El Hagar, dating back to the 26th dynasty and constructed during the reign of renowned Roman emperors. Nearby, you can explore the exquisite rock-cut tombs at the Roman burial site of El Muzawwaqqa.

After lunch, take a leisurely walk through the charming Islamic village of Al Qasr, established in the 12th century. Discover intriguing old houses nestled in narrow alleys, an ancient oil press, a traditional wheat grinder, an old courthouse, and a medieval prison. The village also boasts historic schools and Ayyubid mosques.

Relax in the afternoon by the pool-like hot spring and explore the verdant Dakhla Farms, set against a backdrop of golden sand dunes and clear blue skies. As the day draws to a close, witness the sunset over the Great Sand Sea from the Oasis Hot Springs resort, where you can unwind and marvel at the natural beauty of the surroundings. Later, enjoy dinner before heading to Dakhla Farms to experience the breathtaking sand dunes and stunning sunset views.

For a romantic retreat, consider spending the night at Desert Lodge Hotel in Dakhla, offering panoramic views of the lush green village and the scenic Rose Mountains from its cliff-top location.

Day 6: Kharga Oasis

On the sixth day of your itinerary, after enjoying breakfast, you'll begin your tour from Dakhla Oasis to Kharga Oasis. Your first stop will be Qasr El Labkha, a Roman fortress situated along the ancient caravan route known as the 40-day road, linking Egypt to Sudan (Darb el Arbein). You'll also visit the renowned Kharga Museum.

Next, explore the Temple of Hibis and the Nadura Roman Exterior, followed by a visit to Bagawat, the world's oldest Christian cemetery adorned with chapels featuring remarkably preserved Old Testament Biblical murals.

Continuing onwards, we'll journey to Baris Oasis, the smallest and most charming of the Western Desert oases, where you'll visit the Temple of Dush. Camping amidst the golden sand dunes in Kharga promises an unforgettable experience. The dunes are not only stunning but the campsites offer spacious and comfortable accommodations. There's also a variety of activities to enjoy, including hiking, swimming, and birdwatching.

Day 7: Kharga to Luxor, East Bank Tours

Imagine awakening to breathtaking views of the Golden Sand Dunes before travelling in an airconditioned vehicle to Luxor, one of the world's most renowned ancient cities. Here, you'll embark on a luxurious 5-star Egypt Nile River Cruise, with ample time to explore.

The Temple of Hatshepsut is another remarkable site to visit. It serves as a testament to Egypt's first female ruler and is filled with captivating history and architecture.
