Discover our 6 Days Cairo City and Nile River Cruise itinerary, which covers Cairo's top attractions including the Nile River. You can also opt for a dinner tour on a Felucca, experience Cairo's night atmosphere, visit the Cairo Tower, the pyramids, and other significant landmarks.

Before your cruise, explore the Egyptian Museum in Cairo, home to numerous ancient artifacts. Then embark on a boat ride on the Nile River to explore more historic temples and monuments in Aswan and Luxor. Highlights include the Valley of the Kings in Luxor, the Luxor and Karnak Temples, the Rams Road connecting them, and both the Luxor Museum and the Mummification Museum.

There's a wealth of remarkable sites to see, from ancient statues to grand buildings from bygone eras.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will greet and assist you at Cairo International Airport. You will then be transferred to your hotel in Cairo by a private air-conditioned vehicle. Upon arrival, your 6 Days Cairo and Nile Cruise Wheelchair Accessible Itinerary will be reviewed, and you can discuss any additional excursions you may want to include.

Overnight in Cairo.

Welcome Drink

Day 02: The Great Pyramid, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo

Begin your tour at the Giza Pyramids:

Explore the Great Pyramid of Cheops, built by Snefru's son and known for its grandeur. Visit the second pyramid of Chephren, which is slightly smaller than the Great Pyramid of his father Cheops, and the smallest of the royal pyramids at Giza, constructed for King Mycerinus, one of the final rulers of the Fourth Dynasty before his son King Shepseskaf. Your expert Egyptologist will then guide you to the Sphinx, providing detailed historical insights about this monumental statue. Finally, visit the Valley Temple, also known as the Mummification Temple of King Chephren, built from Aswan granite and adorned with white alabaster.

Afterward, your guide and driver will take you to the Egyptian Museum to marvel at the treasures of Tutankhamun.

Enjoy a delicious lunch before continuing with a tour of Coptic Cairo. Explore ancient churches and synagogues, starting with the Hanging Church, built above the ruins of a Roman fortress, followed by the Cavern Church of Abu Serga, where the Holy Family sought refuge during their journey to Egypt. Visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue, the oldest Jewish temple in Egypt. Return to your hotel for the evening after a gourmet lunch.

Day 03: Cairo to Aswan By Air

Resume your wheelchair accessible tours in Egypt after breakfast at your hotel. Check out, and a representative from Cairo Top Tours will transfer you to Cairo International Airport, approximately a 1-hour drive from Giza.

Fly to Aswan, a 1-hour journey. Upon arrival, you'll be met and transferred to board your 5-star Nile Cruise, one of the top-rated Nile River cruises in Egypt.

In the afternoon, your accredited tour guide and driver will take you for a scenic sail on the River Nile aboard a Felucca, exploring around Kitchener's Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. Enjoy afternoon tea on board.

Dinner will be served as an open-buffet on the boat, accompanied by a Nubian Folkloric show.

You may also opt to attend the sound and light show at Philae Temple to discover the myth of Osiris and Isis in a captivating setting.

Overnight on the Nile Cruise in Aswan.

Day 04: Aswan Tours, Kom Ombo Temple, Sail to Edfu

After enjoying breakfast on your Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor, you'll embark on a tour of Aswan's remarkable modern projects. Visit the impressive Aswan High Dam, the Unfinished Obelisk commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut, and the Temple of Philae, dedicated to the goddess Isis, mother of Horus. You'll also see the two granite lions at the temple entrance, dating from the late Roman era with Byzantine influences.

Return to the Nile Cruise boat, which will then set sail towards Kom Ombo. Enjoy a buffet lunch while cruising. Upon arrival in Kom Ombo, your private guide will take you to the Temple of Kom Ombo, a unique double temple dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Horus. The boat will then sail towards Edfu.

While sailing, enjoy afternoon tea and a welcome cocktail from the Captain. Dinner will be served on board, followed by disco music in the lounge bar for your evening entertainment. Overnight on board in Edfu.

Optional tour to Abu Simbel from Aswan.

Day 05: Edfu Temple, Sail to Luxor

Breakfast will be served on board your boat before you meet your tour guide for a sightseeing excursion to the Temple of Horus in Edfu. This temple features some of the finest Ptolemaic architecture and is dedicated to Horus. A grand granite statue of Horus, adorned with the Double

Crown of Upper and Lower Egypt, stands at the entrance, guarding the temple. After exploring Edfu and learning about its history, you'll return to the Nile Cruise ship and continue sailing to Luxor.

Lunch and afternoon tea will be served on board. In the evening, enjoy a high-quality dinner and a traditional Galabya party on the ship.

Overnight in Luxor.

Day 06: Luxor Excursions, Back to Cairo for Final Departure

On your final day of the Egypt tours, enjoy breakfast aboard the Nile cruise vessel before disembarking. The day is packed with fascinating Luxor tours. Start by visiting the Valley of the Kings, where pharaohs from the 18th, 19th, and 20th dynasties chose their eternal resting places. Next, explore the Colossi of Memnon and the Temple of El Deir El Bahari, which was built as a mortuary temple for Queen Hatshepsut.

After your tour of Luxor's West Bank, proceed to the East Bank to visit the magnificent Karnak Temple complex and the Luxor Temple.

There is an optional hot air balloon ride available for an additional cost.

In the afternoon, you'll fly back to Cairo for your final departure from Cairo International Airport, concluding your 6-day Cairo and Nile Cruise Wheelchair Accessible Itinerary.
