1-Day Trekking Palace of Abbas Basha in Sinai

Our trek will cover: El Milga - Abu Jeefa - Wadi Tubug - Wadi Zawatiin - Jebel Abbas Basha, a dark volcanic mountain with an incomplete stone palace - Wadi Talah - and then return.

Abbas Basha, an Ottoman ruler, hoped that living in Sinai would cure his illness. Unfortunately, he passed away before completing his palace.

After dinner at the camp, you'll spend the night there and return to Cairo the following morning.
