Itinerary

Day 1 (Arrival at Cairo)

Arrive at Cairo International Airport, Meet and assist at Cairo International Airport by the representative of Cairo Top Tours and take the way to your hotel next to the pyramids, and have the first night in Cairo.

Day 2 (Giza Piramids & Saqqara)

After having breakfast at the hotel, we will have the first day of visits to the following sites: Enjoy the <u>tour to Giza of the pyramids</u>. After that, you will move to enjoy the first pyramid in all of Egypt "The Pyramid of Zoser" in Saqqara, and take a look at the tombs of the nobles. At night, we can make an optional visit to the sound and light show * Optional *

Day 3 (Luxor/ East Bank)

Early in the morning, our representative will accompany you to Cairo airport to take your flight national to Luxor. Upon arrival at Luxor airport, you will be joined by your guide to check in for your Nile cruise.

After lunch, visit the east bank of Luxor, starting with Karnak Temple, considered the largest temple complex ever built by man.

This large complex was dedicated to the chief god of the ancient Egyptians <u>Amun-Ra</u> together with his triad which consists of Mut and Khonso. Visit Luxor Temple, the southernmost of the Theban East Bank monuments, located in the heart of ancient Thebes and, like Karnak, was dedicated to Amun-Ra.

Night in Luxor.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch and Dinner

Day 4 (Luxor/ West Bank)

After breakfast, visit the West Bank of Luxor starting with the Valley of the Kings, which contains 62 tombs to date, excavated by Egyptologists and archaeologists from many countries. In 1922, Howard Carter found the last and best known of these tombs, that of the young pharaoh Tutankhamun. Visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (Deir el-Bahari) designed on multiple levels, the temple itself consisted of three-wide courtyards separated by colonnades, linked by ascending ramps, and delimited by clad limestone walls.

Before leaving the West Bank, we will stop at the Colossi of Memnon, which are two gigantic statues seated representing Amenopis III facing the Nile.

Day 5 (Kom Ombo & Edfu)

Have a hearty breakfast on board. After lunch, the private Nile cruise will start sailing towards Kom Ombo. Begin the tour to Kom Ombo by visiting the Temple of Kom Ombo, where African elephants were bred and trained to be used in the army. African elephants were bred and trained to be used in the army. This temple was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and one of the forms of the god Horus called god-Haroeris. then, the ship sets sail for the city of Edfu while dinner is served on board and overnight on board.

Day 6 : Aswan sightseeing

After breakfast, begin your excursions to Aswan with a visit to the Aswan High Dam, the High Dam is considered an exceptional an exceptional engineering marvel and is among the most important projects in Egypt's modern history. Then continue to see the obelisk. It is located in granite quarries where you can see the Unfinished Obelisk, which is believed to have been built by Queen Hatshepsut, who ruled Egypt during the New Kingdom. It is located in a red granite quarry quarried during the time of Queen Hatshepsut.

After the tours of Aswan, you will be transferred back to the Nile cruise ship and then dinner will be served on board the ship and you will spend the night onboard the ship. dinner will be served on board the boat and overnight in Aswan.

Day 7 : Back to Cairo

After breakfast, you will depart from your Nile cruise and make your way back to Aswan airport for your flight back to Cairo. in Cairo, you will meet our representative at the airport, who will escort you to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 8 : Visiting Egyptian museum and Coptic Cairo

In the morning, you will start your tour in downtown Cairo visiting the famous Egyptian museum and the ancient "Coptic Cairo" area, where the sacred churches and the synagogue of the Jewish temple are located. After the tour, you will take the way back to your hotel.

Day 9 : Alexandria Day tour

After breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your guide to begin your day trip to Alexandria from Cairo, the beautiful city that was established in 332 B.C. by the great Macedonian commander and ruler Alexander the Great, and remains the capital of Egypt for nearly 1,000 years.

First, you will see the Pillar of Pompey, which is located inside the ruined Serapeum of Alexandria, then transfer to see the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, which is an ancient catacomb, composed of three floors underground. Also, adorned from the inside with a mixture of Pharaonic and Greco-Roman styles of art and architecture. Transfer to the Citadel of Qaitbay, which is built with the ruined stones of the ancient Pharos lighthouse.

We will pass the modern Bibliotheca of Alexandria on our way to enjoy a local lunch.

Overnight in Cairo. Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 10 : fly to Jordan

Our representative will take you to Cairo airport for your international flight to Jordan. When you land at Amman airport, of course, we will be there to meet you and transfer you to the hotel where you will stay for the rest of your tour. There are no tours scheduled for today, so once you have checked in and we have confirmed the pick-up time for the following day, we will be there to meet you and transfer you to the hotel where you will stay for the remainder of your tour. pick-up time for the next day, you will have the rest of the day to yourself.

Day 11 : Visiting Madaba and Mount Nebo

Enjoy breakfast, as usual, then we will pick you up and drive to Madaba, where we will visit St. George's Church in Madaba to see an amazing 6th-century mosaic map of Palestine. Next, we will head to Mount Nebo, also known as Mount Moses because it is believed that it was here that Moses was first shown the Promised Land. After visiting Mount Nebo, it will be time to visit the Dead Sea, which is the lowest point on earth. After relaxing or floating in the water, or even enjoying a special beauty treatment, as evening approaches, we will drive you back to your hotel in Amman.

Day 12 : visiting the Lost City of Petra

Today is likely to be one of the highlights of your tour because today we will visit the Lost City of Petra, one of the most amazing archaeological sites in the world. We recommend wearing comfortable shoes for this tour because it involves a lot of walking. Petra is an ancient city that was excavated into the sides of a deep gorge and often a narrow gorge. called Treasury which is located at the far end of the site, about 1 km from the entrance to the gorge. entrance to the gorge. In short, if there is one place in Jordan that you can't miss, this is it. After your tour, you will return to your hotel where you will spend the last night of your adventure in Turkey, Egypt and Jordan.
