Itinerary

Tour to Philae Temple, High Dam and the Unfinished Obelisk from Aswan

A knowledgeable tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will pick you up from any hotel in Aswan to start your delightful Aswan day tours from our Egypt day tours collection, beginning with a fascinating visit to Philae Temple. Your journey kicks off with a tour of the High Dam, an engineering marvel built in the 1960s that created the largest artificial lake in the world. The dam was constructed to protect Egypt from the destructive annual Nile floods and severe droughts, effectively managing the water throughout the year. During its construction, the High Dam generated about 50% of Egypt's electricity, bringing power to many of the country's villages for the first time.

Next, you'll visit the granite quarries in Aswan, the source of the durable stone used by the ancient Egyptians for their statues, buildings, and especially their obelisks. Here, you'll find the Unfinished Obelisk, offering insight into the ancient methods of carving and extracting these massive structures. This obelisk is believed to have been commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut, one of ancient Egypt's most powerful female rulers.

The tour continues with a visit to the majestic Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis. The temple was saved from submersion by an international campaign that relocated it to its current island location, accessible by a scenic boat ride. Philae Temple became a significant religious centre during the Ptolemaic Dynasty and remained an active site of ancient Egyptian worship even after the spread of Christianity in Egypt. The temple includes the Mammissi, or birth house, of Horus, the son of Isis and Osiris and the protector of kingship.

Finally, you'll be transferred back to your hotel in Aswan or to Aswan Airport.
