Itinerary

Day use in Fayoum

You will be picked up from your Cairo hotel for a one-day excursion to Fayoum in a private AC vehicle with a professional tour guide, followed by visits.

Lahoun Pyramid:

The pyramid measures 48 meters in length and is located in Fayoum Governorate. The pyramid is constructed of mud bricks atop a high hill, and its inner core is entirely made of rock. Below the pyramid, corridors led to the room where King Senusret II was buried.

Hawara Pyramid:

The Hawara Pyramid is one of Egypt's pyramids. It was created by the pharaoh of Egypt, Amenemhat III of the 12th Dynasty, in the town of Hawara, 9 km southeast of the city of Faiyum. It is made of mud bricks covered with limestone.

Kom Oshim Museum:

The Kom Oshim Museum is a museum dedicated to displaying archaeological remains, statues, and artefacts, the most notable of which is a group of mummy images discovered in Fayoum and belonging to the inhabitants of the Ptolemaic town of Karanis, and visitors from groups or individuals can tour the museum, see the displayed pieces, and read the identification panels specific to each piece.

Then you'll have a great lunch at an oriental restaurant. Then take a felucca cruise on the famous Nile River. Then you'll be taken to the drop-off site, which marks the conclusion of our service.
