Day 1: Travel from Cairo to Luxor.

Valley of the Kings: here, find the secret underground burial chambers of ancient Egyptian kings built in a way to deter thieves from stealing their corpses.

Hatshepsut Temple: see the beautifully built cinerary temple of one of the greatest rulers, queen Hatshepsut.

Colossi of Memnon: here are the huge two statues of Amenhotep III known for their detailed relief of the king's wives and children.

Make sure to take a break to have a yummy meal at a well-appointed Nile-side restaurant, which provides a bay view and local food at its best.

Karnak Temple: Realize the last day of your Luxor tour in this vast religious area considered as home of the tallest pillars ever erected and almost the many worked historical events.

At night, board a first-class train for a comfortable journey to Aswan. After that, you will go to your hotel rated five stars where you will have a good night's sleep.

Day 2: Aswan Tour

On Day Two: Enjoy your delicious breakfast and get ready for the adventure of visiting the attractions in Aswan. First on your list will be:

The Aswan High Dam.

This is a multipurpose dam that helps produce hydroelectric power, controls the floods of the Nile River in Egypt, and helps conserve the water during dry seasons.

The unfinished obelisk.

This particular obelisk was already drawn from the crystals, but they later discovered that this piece of granite was still connected to its source and hence it would be quite risky to pursue it any further since the surface was beginning to crack already.

Philae temple.

On the inside walls of this temple exists the timeless and world-famous myth about Osiris and his beloved sister Isis.

Reservations can be done right now in order of the full history of the temple.

Then it's time for your delectable lunch. as you will do it at a local eatery within Aswan city.
