Memphis Saqqara Day Tour

Our Cairo Top Tour representative will pick you up from your hotel and transfer you to start your Cairo day trip to visit Sakkara and Memphis city, first, you will visit Sakkara where you will see the 'Complex of King Zoser and The step pyramid of Djoser which is the first pyramid built in Egypt and the first monumental step pyramid in history.

There are several other monuments in the same place; pyramid complex of Unas and Userkaf and several other tombs that belong to high officials from the pharaonic era which has many scenes that are preserved in bright colors. Also, it is adorned by fantastic architectural masterpieces as the Museum of Imhotep – the architect who worked on the pyramid of Zoser the kind's steps.

Next, we will go to Memphis it was one of the two capitals of Egypt until around 2200 B.C. In the Post-Pre-Dynastic period after consolidation between Upper and Lower Egypt, it emerged as the first capital. It is an open-air museum consisting of many temples and monuments of the god Ptah, the god of creation and works of art Even for lunch, you will participate in a delicious meal at a quality restaurant in Saqqara then you will be provided with a pickup service back to your hotel or other desired destination once you enjoyed the Egypt day tours.
