Day Trip to Saqqara, Felucca Sunset Cairo, and BBQ Lunch Buffet

Welcome to Egypt. Our tour leader will meet you in Cairo or Giza for a day trip to Saqqara, where you can visit King Zoser's complex, built during the 3rd dynasty by his vizier and architect Imhotep, who designed the first step pyramid in history. After visiting the pyramid, explore the king's funeral complex, where he held his Heb-Sed Festival after 30 years of reign.

We will visit another major pyramid in Saqqara, the pyramid of King Unas from the fifth dynasty. This pyramid was inscribed with the famous Pyramid text to facilitate the king's resurrection in the afterlife. Don't forget to question the tour guide about the history of the Pyramid text and its connection to the deceased. Following that, we will gladly bring you to Saqqara's Serapeum, which was previously used to worship the Apis bull. The Serapeum is just an underground corridor that leads to chambers containing numerous sarcophagi. Then, you will be astounded when you witness the tombs of the Nobles, which were created for royal and non-royal persons in Saqqara like the workers, priests, officials, soldiers, vizirs, and princes.

Now it's time to relax in the Nile while riding your felucca in the Nile River to stay warm and observe the sunset before heading to your great BBQ lunch. Then you can shop for souvenirs. It is a pleasant memory that you will cherish when you return to your home country and recall Egypt. Then you'll be transferred to your destination.
