Most people do not know that there are many more pyramids in Egypt than there are in the Giza pyramids. A new exposition is available for visiting; it is the Meidum archaeological site built for King Snefru, who at the beginning of the fourth dynasty belonged to the Old Kingdom of Egypt's history.

However, the pyramid is one of the total of 4 pyramids of Snefru who was the father of King Cheops. Due to assumptions of owning the Great Pyramid at Giza Necropolis, the credit goes to Cheops.

Pyramid of Meidum is situated in the town of Meidum, Al Wasta, Beni Suef Governorate about ninety kilometers in the south-west of Cairo. It is a rather curious monument, which construction was finalized by Senefru, the founder of the fourth dynasty (who started construction during the end of the last kings of the third dynasty), its form is rather close to the step-pyramid, however, it has an outer layer.

Itinerary

Cairo Half Day Tour to Meidum Archaeological Site

You will be greeted by our tour guide to commence any of our private Egypt Day trips to discover Cairo Day Trip to Meidum which is near Giza Necropolis, Tombs of the Nobles in Saqqara, or Dahshur Necropolis.

Your certified Egyptologist will accompany you with an exclusive deluxe vehicle to the area of Meidum where one of the four pyramids built for King Snefru of the fourth dynasty has been attempted with the help of the Red Pyramid to reach a perfect shape in Dahshur, you will witness a great representation of the mastaba pyramids (stepped pyramids) of King Djoser in Saqqara, the pyramid in Meidum Nowadays, three upper stairs are preserved only, which are rising, as it were, out of sand and piles of ruined stones, and this is quite interesting.

The pyramid dedicated to Snefru, the father of Cheops, rises in the middle of the desert, and beside it there are several dozen small Mastabas. To date only the construction of the Meidum pyramid is preserved, located in a corner of the desert, near numerous small mastabas; this pyramid was constructed by Pharaoh Snefru, the father of King Cheops. It was first constructed in the geometrical pattern of stairs and then in the reign of King Senefru they attempted to alter the form of the pyramid from a step pyramid to an entire pyramid by filling the distances between the stairs with a limestone cover After your Cairo Day Tours you will visit one of the government-authorized papyrus institutes where you will get a brief insight on how the initial forms of papers were found in Egypt in early history.

After the tour of Piramide Meidum, the client can be transferred back to any desired destination.
