Itinerary

Day 1: Giza Pyramids - Saqqara - Memphis

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, Cairo Top Tours will provide a private vehicle to accompany you to your hotel in Cairo or Giza. The tour includes a visit to the Giza Pyramids, including the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, which was built 4500 years ago as an eternal home for the semi-god king. The pyramids are impressive, standing at 146 meters and 230 meters long on each side.

The tour continues to the high plateau, where you can see the three pyramids, including the pyramids of King Chephren and King Mycerinus, as well as the queen's pyramids. A Bedouin guide will take amazing photos while you enjoy a camel ride around the Giza Pyramids.

The Sphinx of Giza is part of the pyramid complex and is believed to be built for the king himself, symbolizing his power as a lion and genius as a human. The Valley Temple of Chephren is also nearby, where the mummification of the royal body took place during funeral rituals.

After lunch, you will continue your tour of Giza, visiting Saqqara, the necropolis of an earlier period 200 years before the great kings who built the pyramids. You will see the first-ever stone pyramid, the Step Pyramid, and the tomb of King Teti, who ruled Egypt during the 6th dynasty.

Next, you will visit Memphis, the ancient city of Egypt, an open-air museum with many artifacts and statues of King Ramses II, and the alabaster sphinx, the second biggest in Egypt's history. After finishing your Cairo trips, you can enjoy activities like the Sound and Light Show in Giza Pyramids or a fancy Nile Dinner Cruise in Cairo.

Day 2: Saladin Citadel / Coptic Cairo / Khan El-Khalili

Enjoy a delicious breakfast at your hotel before meeting an expert Egyptologist guide for an Islamic and Coptic Cairo tour. Start with the Citadel of Saladin, built by Muslim leader Saladin El-Ayyubi in the 12th century, which features the Mosque of Mohamed Ali, a mosque influenced by Turkish architecture. Mohamed Ali was brought by the Ottoman Sultan from Albania to end French occupation in Egypt, but he took over the country in 1805 and ruled solely.

Next, visit the Roman Fortress of Babylon, which is almost ruined except for the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary. Visit the Cavern Church of St. Serius and the oldest Synagogue of Ben Ezra, once a Christian Church sold to a Jewish wealthy man.

Enjoy a delicious lunch before enjoying a shopping tour in the famous Khan El-Khalili market. Enjoy tea mint or fresh mango juice in a local cafe while watching street life and sellers in Al Hussein. Your tour guide will show you interesting buildings from early times during your Islamic Cairo trips.
