The palace of Abden:

The series started with the palace being prepared for Khedive Ismail's thirtieth birthday celebration in Abdeen Palace. This indicates that the ceremony took place in 1860, before the construction of Abdeen Palace, which was finished in 1872 and turned into a government center.
