Itinerary

Day 01 : Alexandria to the Pyramids & Egyptian Museum Tour

Upon your cruise's arrival at Alexandria Port, our Egyptologist will meet you at the exit gate, holding a sign with your name. From there, you'll be transported to Cairo in a modern, air-conditioned vehicle.

Once in Cairo, your tour begins at the Giza Plateau. Explore the grandeur of the Great Pyramid of Cheops, and enjoy photo opportunities with guidance from your expert. You'll also visit the Pyramid of Chephren and the Pyramid of Mycerinus. At the end of your Giza tour, marvel at the Great Sphinx and the Valley Temple, renowned for its role in the mummification process.

Following a delightful lunch at a local restaurant, you'll head to the Egyptian Museum. Spend two hours marveling at ancient artifacts, including the treasures of Tutankhamun, such as his golden mask and chariots.

After your sightseeing, you'll be transferred to a comfortable 5-star hotel in Cairo for an overnight stay.

Day 02: Alexandria Sightseeing Tour

Start your day with breakfast at the hotel before embarking on the second part of your 2-day tour from Alexandria Port. You'll be transported by a modern, air-conditioned vehicle with your personal guide and driver as you journey from Cairo to Alexandria.

Your first stop will be the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, Egypt's largest Roman burial site, featuring three levels of tombs and intricate decorations from a wealthy Romanized Egyptian family. Next, visit Pompey's Pillar, the sole remaining column from the ancient Serapeum temple.

Explore the Citadel of Qaitbey, built by the Mamluk rulers to defend against Ottoman threats, standing on the site of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

Discover the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a modern marvel built to honor the ancient library, renowned as a hub of learning and research with its extensive collection of 8 million books.

Visit the Church of San Marco, one of Africa's oldest churches, and stroll through Alexandria's historic center, enjoying the local markets that offer sweets and traditional Egyptian treats. Explore the Mansheya district with its narrow streets, the women's market (Zan'et Elsetat), and the gold market, known for its wedding and engagement jewelry.

Next, see the impressive Abbo Elabbas Mosque, and experience a local funfair where you can see old-fashioned carousels and traditional activities. Capture beautiful photos of the Corniche and the old port, with its picturesque fishing boats and local fishermen.

After a delightful lunch, your guide will escort you back to Alexandria Port, where you'll be dropped off at your cruise ship.
