Day 01 : Alexandria Port to the Pyramids Tour

Upon your arrival at Alexandria Port, our representative will meet you outside the exit gate, holding a sign with the Cairo Top Tours logo and your name.

You'll embark on a private journey in one of our modern, air-conditioned vehicles, with a professional driver taking you to Cairo. The transfer typically takes around 3 hours, including a brief restroom stop.

Begin your Cairo adventure with a visit to the Giza Pyramids. Our knowledgeable Egyptologist will provide insights and answer any questions about these iconic structures. Explore the pyramids of King Chephren and Menkaure, and marvel at the grand Sphinx, featuring a human head and lion's body.

Next, visit the Valley Temple, known for its role in the mummification process during King Chephren's era. Enjoy a meal at a local restaurant before heading to Saqqara.

At Saqqara, you'll see the Step Pyramid, the world's first stone building, and have access to the Pyramid of Teti and a well-preserved tomb showcasing scenes from ancient Egyptian life.

Conclude the day with a check-in at your Cairo hotel, where you'll spend the night.

Day 02 : the Egyptian Museum & Salah Edin Citadel Tour

Day two of our excursion begins with a morning pickup for the scenic drive to the Nile Delta region. Our first stop is a rural farming village where we'll join locals for a traditional breakfast of full medames and flatbread.

Next, we'll take a short boat ride through lush agricultural lands dotted with palm trees. Keep an eye out for waterbirds along the waterways. Afterwards, learn the art of weaving bamboo goods at a family workshop.

Following lunch at a lakeside café, we head inland to the town of Damanhur. Here fascinating ruins of the ancient Persian-inspired White Walls and temples await exploration.

Our last visit was to a papyrus paper production facility. Witness the intricate process of creating these traditional writing materials still used today.

Retracing our route in the golden late afternoon light, we return to Alexandria enriched by experiences off the beaten path. Friendly encounters provide heartfelt glimpses into Delta culture.
