Afterward, your guide will lead you on a journey through the historic district of Islamic Cairo. You'll be captivated by the ancient city walls, gates, and alleyways dating back to the Fatimid dynasty in the 10th century A.D.

Finally, stroll through the lively Khan El Khalili Bazaar, where you can unwind with a cup of mint tea at the famous Al-Fishawy cafe and enjoy a wonderful shopping experience, perfect for picking up souvenirs and gifts.

An optional evening tour to see the dazzling Sound and Light Show at the Pyramids of Giza is also available.
