## [Itinerary](#)

### **Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours**

You will be met and supported by our agent upon arrival at [Aswan Airport](#), then you will board your [Egypt Nile River Cruise](#) and have lunch before [Aswan tours](#), after which you will begin your [Aswan day tours](#) with our tour guide visiting [the Aswan High Dam](#), whose foundation was laid by the Soviet Union in the 1960s to save Egypt from the seasonal [Nile](#) floodwaters.

You will also visit the [Temple of Philae](#) during the [excursions in Aswan](#) which was built to honor the goddess of magic in [ancient Egypt religion](#), [Goddess Isis](#), the temple was built in the [Greco-Roman](#) style overlooking the Nile River which makes it one of the most beautiful temples in Egypt, then we will be back to the Nile Cruise boat and relax while having your afternoon tea after the long day of your [Aswan Excursions](#), then the Captain's welcome cocktail. You will have your dinner aboard the ship, then continue to watch a [Nubian](#) show.

### **Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples**

You will begin your day by having a delightful breakfast aboard the MS Esplanade Nile Cruise, then your Egypt Nile River Cruise will continue to sail to Kom Ombo to enjoy an amazing [Tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu](#), meet with your Egyptologist guide in the lobby to explore [the Temple of Kom Ombo](#), built during the reign of the [Ptolemies in Egypt](#) to honor the two gods of the region [Sobek](#), the crocodile and Haroeris, the falcon-god of Kom Ombo, when you are done you will sail directly to Edfu. You will have your delicious lunch aboard, then proceed to visit [Horus](#) Temple at [Edfu](#), Horus is the protector of kingship and the son of [Osiris](#), then move to have dinner on board, after you finish your Egypt Day Tours, you will get ready to sail to Esna to attend an Egyptian Galabeya Party, you will spend the night in Esna and get ready for tomorrow's [Luxor excursions](#).

### **Day 3: Sunday - Luxor East Bank Tours**

You will have Breakfast aboard the boat, then your comfortable MS Esplanade Nile cruise will proceed to sail towards Luxor via Esna lock, You will enjoy your lunch aboard then you will relax while having your Afternoon tea, then continue your [Luxor day tours](#) to visit [Luxor Temple](#), The temple is built by the reputable Pharaoh [Amenophis the third](#) and it is dedicated to [Amun](#), Mut, and [Khonsu](#) and was the focus of

one of the most significant religious festivals in ancient Egypt – the annual Opet Festival.

During this festival the cult statues of Amun. Resume [Luxor East Bank Tours](#) to visit [Karnak Temples](#), dedicated to the Triad of Thebes headed by the Sun-God [Amun-Re](#) and his Consort the Cat-Goddes Mut and their son the god of the moon in ancient Egypt ( Khonso ). After [Luxor Sightseeing tours](#) are over, you will have your dinner aboard the [Nile Cruise](#) while watching a belly dance show

## Day 4: Monday - Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours

At the end of your [Luxor West Bank Tours](#), you will stop to see the [Colossi of Memnon](#) which are two enormous colossal statues built for King [Amenhotep III](#), father of Akhenaten, and were put inside a temple that was standing before.
