Itinerary

Day 01: Check in- Luxor East Bank

Upon your arrival at Luxor airport or train station, our representative will transfer you to your Nile cruise in a private, air-conditioned van. In the afternoon, you'll explore Luxor's east bank, starting with the impressive Karnak temple complex—one of the largest structures ever built. Its main building, dedicated to the god Amun-Re, is considered the earthly residence of the god and dates back to the Middle Kingdom, with references to even older structures from the 3rd dynasty. Later, visit Luxor Temple, originally built by a 12th Dynasty king and completed by the renowned King Ramses II.

After completing your day's tour, you'll return to your boat for relaxation and refreshments. In the evening, enjoy an Egyptian folkloric show organized by the staff, followed by dinner and an overnight stay in Luxor. (L-D). You also have the option to experience the Karnak Sound and Light Show, showcasing the beauty of this sacred site at night!

N.B: If your arrival time in Luxor is very early, we will begin the tour immediately upon your arrival to maximize your time, as cruise check-in is prioritized to avoid waiting in the lobby.

Meals included: Lunch and dinner.

Day 02: Luxor West Bank - Sail to Edfu

Enjoy breakfast on your Egypt Nile River Cruise. Then, embark on a magical tour to Thebes, the sacred land, starting with the west bank of Luxor. Explore the Valley of the Kings, the royal burial ground of Theban kings and ancient Egyptian rulers, where pharaohs were laid to rest. Next, visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El Bahari, renowned for its remarkable ancient Egyptian architecture carved directly into the mountainside. Conclude your tour with a visit to the Colossi of Memnon, statues belonging to King Amenhotep III. Return to your boat for lunch, followed by a relaxing afternoon. Dinner and overnight stay on the cruise.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 03: Edfu - Kom Ombo - Sail to Aswan

Start your day with breakfast onboard your Nile cruise. Your tour guide will then lead you on an intriguing journey into the land of secrets. Today's adventure begins with a visit to one of Egypt's most magnificent temples, the Temple of Horus at Edfu, renowned for being exceptionally well-preserved. Afterward, return to your ship for lunch served onboard while sailing to the city of Kom Ombo.

In the afternoon, venture out to explore the Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to the gods Sobek and Haroeris for a period. Return to your boat and enjoy lunch. Relax on the sunny terrace and take in the breathtaking scenery of the mighty Nile River, the cradle of ancient Egyptian civilization.

Dinner will be served onboard as you sail towards the city of Aswan. Arrive in Aswan late in the evening and overnight onboard.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 04: Aswan City Tour

Breakfast will be served on board your boat. Later, you will join your guide to explore the magnificent city of Aswan, including the High Dam. The High Dam was constructed by Egyptian President Gamal Abdel Nasser in 1960 to protect Egypt from Nile floods and provide hydroelectric power. You'll have the opportunity to marvel at this impressive engineering feat.

Next, you'll embark on a motorboat journey along the Nile to the island of Agilika. Here, you'll visit the Philae Temple, which dates back to the Greco-Roman period and is dedicated to the goddess Isis, the mother of the god Horus. Discover the rich history and intricate architecture of this ancient temple.

To conclude the day's excursions, you'll be accompanied to visit the Unfinished Obelisk, one of Aswan's most captivating tourist attractions. This massive red granite obelisk was intended to honor the god Amun Re but remains unfinished, providing insight into the ancient Egyptian civilization's craftsmanship and techniques.

After the tour, you'll return to your boat for a delicious lunch served on board. In the afternoon, enjoy a refreshing cup of tea during the afternoon tea session on the boat. The evening is free for you to relax and unwind. You'll savor a delightful dinner on board and spend the night in Aswan.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 05: Disembarkation from cruise - Departure to Cairo

Departure after breakfast. Our representative will then accompany you to Aswan airport for your flight to Cairo (breakfast included).

Optional Excursion: Excursion to the temples of Abu Simbel by private coach or domestic flight: An English-speaking guide will meet you in Aswan and transfer you by private air-conditioned van to Abu Simbel, located south of Aswan on the west bank of the Nile, 180 miles south of the First Cataract, in ancient Nubia. The site, known as Meha in ancient times, was first documented in the 18th Dynasty.

Explore the temples of Abu Simbel, commissioned by the renowned King Ramses II. The larger temple, the Great Temple, was dedicated to the god Rahorakhty. The smaller temple was dedicated to King Ramses II himself and his beloved wife, Queen Nefertari. After your tour, return to Aswan. Upon arrival, transfer by private air-conditioned van to your chosen hotel for check-in, relaxation, and refreshment, or transfer to Aswan Airport for your domestic flight to Cairo.

Meals included: Breakfast.
