Day 1: Karnak, and Luxor Temples

Our representative will meet you at Luxor Airport, the train station, or your hotel in Luxor. You'll then be transferred by private air-conditioned vehicle to the MS Radamis I Nile Cruise, where lunch will be served

on board.

Your tour guide will accompany you to visit the renowned temples of Karnak and Luxor. The Luxor Temples form a vast ancient Egyptian temple complex situated on the eastern bank of the Nile in what is now Luxor, built around 1400 BC.

Experience the temple either early in the morning, before the crowds arrive, or later in the evening at sunset when the stones take on a radiant glow. Afterward, return to your Nile cruise for dinner and overnight stay on board in Luxor.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Day Tour

Enjoy breakfast aboard the MS Radamis I Nile Cruise, followed by a guided tour to explore Luxor's West Bank. Visit the Valley of the Kings, the temple of Hatshepsut at El Deir El Bahari, and the Colossi of Memnon. The Colossi of Memnon are two massive stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III, who ruled Egypt during the 18th Dynasty around 1350 BC. These statues were a popular tourist attraction even during the Greco-Roman period. Return to your Nile cruise for dinner and spend the night on board in Luxor.

Day 3: Edfu & Kom Ombo Sightseeing

Enjoy breakfast aboard the MS Radamis I Nile Cruise, followed by a guided tour to explore the magnificent Edfu Temple. The Temple of Horus (Edfu Temple), constructed between 237 and 57 BC, stands as one of Egypt's best-preserved ancient monuments, protected by desert sands. After returning on board for lunch, depart for Aswan to visit Kom Ombo, an unusual double temple located in the city of Kom Ombo.

Day 4: Aswan Day Tour

After breakfast aboard the MS Radamis I Nile cruise, you will be taken to view the Great Temple of Philae, the Unfinished Obelisk, and the High Dam by our tour guide. The last temple constructed in the classical Egyptian architecture was the Great Temple of Philae, dedicated to the goddess Isis. Its building got begun in 690 B.C. After supper, head back to your Nile cruise ship at Luxor for the night. translate it with separate information for both Americans and British

Day 5: Final departure

Enjoy breakfast aboard the MS Radamis I Nile Cruise, after which our tour guide will accompany you to Aswan Airport, the railway station, or your hotel in Aswan.
