Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Upon arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative assigned by Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you at the airport.

He will transport you to your hotel in Cairo by an air-conditioned vehicle and facilitate to you all the check-in procedures and review your Egypt 12 days Itinerary to confirm all pick-up times of your tour package and any optional activity you would like to book.

Overnight and get ready for your next morning trip to the Pyramids of Egypt.

Day 2: Pyramids and Sphinx Excursion

On the second day, enjoy your tasty breakfast in the hotel and you will meet your Egyptologist guide at the hotel lobby to start your adventure during the <u>Giza pyramids tour</u> and see the <u>Sphinx</u> too which was thought to be built for King <u>Chephren</u>, the owner of the middle pyramid.

You will get surprised during your <u>tour of the Giza Pyramids</u> as you are observing the greatest of the seven wonders of the world that had been built before Century by thousands of years to memorize the names of the great Pharaohs <u>Cheops</u>, Chephren, and <u>Mycerinus</u>.

Enjoy your lunch in a very tremendous local restaurant and overnight in your hotel in Cairo.

Day 3: Alexandria Trip

We will proceed with our <u>tours in Egypt</u> by a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle for about 2 hours drive after you enjoy your breakfast, starting to spend your day tour to Alexandria from Cairo on the Mediterranean Sea which was constructed by <u>Alexander the Great</u> during the Greco-Roman Era and used to be the most beautiful city in the whole world at that time and one of largest cities in Egypt.

You will visit the Greco-Roman sites like the <u>Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa</u>, the ruins of the Roman temple complex, known as Pompey's pillar, and the Citadel of Qaitbay, the huge defensive fortification constructed in the 15th century and it is located on the Mediterranean seacoast, on the base where the famous lighthouse Pharos (one of the seven man-made wonders of the world) used to be standing, visit the modern Bibliotheca of Alexandria, which is one of the most substantial cultural centers all over Egypt, and have a gourmet fresh seafood at a very good quality restaurant,

then move to your hotel in Alexandria for overnight.

Day 4: Alexandria to Cairo - Egyptian Museum - Train to Aswan

After having your daily breakfast at the hotel, resume your enjoyable <u>Cairo day tours</u>. we will transfer you to the great <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo downtown presenting the largest and most unparalleled collection of Egyptian antiquities all over the world and the only royal treasure that was found in good condition, the treasures of the golden pharaoh <u>Tutankhamen</u>.

A delicate lunch in a good local restaurant will be served before being transferred to the train station to take the sleeping train heading to Aswan.

Day 5: Arrive Aswan - Aswan Excursions

Breakfast on the train then you will get off at Aswan! One of the most pretty cities in Egypt, here you can see the Nile River with a different view and discover the honorable Egyptian history. Today we will have a great time during <u>Aswan Day tours</u> to see the most admirable sites.

Visit the Aswan High Dam built-in 1960 to save Egypt from the floods happening every year, then a visit to Philae Temple and its amazing stones and carvings which have been saved for thousands of years to tell us about how much our ancestors were great and advanced.

After that, you will be moved out to your hotel in Aswan for check-in and overnight.

Day 6: Abu Simbel Temples

After breakfast, you will have a memorable experience visiting Abu Simbel Temples. The twin temples, built during the reign of <u>Ramses II</u>, were carved out of the mountainside in the 13th century B.C, and during the 19th dynasty.

They are monuments to the king and his Queen <u>Nefertari</u>, and to honor his triumph at the Battle of Kadesh, their huge external rock relief figures have become iconic.

After this exciting trip, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Aswan and overnight.

Day 7: Aswan to Luxor - Luxor Temple

Welcome to Luxor, the greatest open-air museum! Enjoy your amazing breakfast at your hotel in Aswan you will be transferred to enjoy <u>Luxor day tours</u> and visit the beautiful <u>temple of Luxor</u>, which is a large Ancient Egyptian temple existing at the east bank of the Nile River which was built by King <u>Amenhotep III</u> in the 18th Dynasty (<u>New Kingdom</u>) and was completed by <u>Ramses II</u> during the 19th Dynasty.

After that, you will be transferred to your hotel in Luxor for check-in and overnight.

Day 8: Karnak Temple - Luxor West Bank - Transfer to Hurghada by Land

The temple is dedicated to the God Amon, his wife the well-known Goddess Mut, and their son Khonsu. It was constructed from the beginning of the <u>Middle Kingdom</u> to the Graeco-Roman Kingdom by many Kings.

Also, you will visit the monuments of the West bank of the Nile, Hatshepsut Temple in Deir Al-Bahari, Valley of the Kings, and Colossi of Memnon before moving to Hurghada by land for about 3 hours drive to overnight in your Hurghada hotel.

Day 9: Submarine Excursion in Hurghada
