Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

On arrival at Cairo International Airport, you will be greeted and accompanied by our guide in an exclusively air-conditioned vehicle to your preferred hotel in Cairo, upon checking in, the tour leader will ensure that everything you need for the 6 days in Egypt package, is arranged, whether it is the room, or any addition that you need or any change in the itinerary.

Have the opportunity to visit the great Sound and Light show at the Giza Pyramids if time is on your side on your first visit to the hotel. The show is like an Opera show spoken by the voice of the Great Sphinx who will narrate the history of Egyptian civilization as the gigantic Giza Pyramids light up in the night of the Desert.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids - Egyptian Museum - Coptic Cairo Tour

The tour begins with breakfast with an Egyptologist tour guide, who takes visitors to the Pyramids of Giza. The guide provides a brief history of Egypt, taking visitors to the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, constructed during his rule period of 2500 BC. The tour then moves to the second pinnacle, where visitors can view the second pyramid of King Chephren and the entire Giza plateau. The tour continues with the Valley Temple, where the actual mummification of the king was held, and the Great Sphinx, believed to have been carved by King Chephren's order.

During the day tours to Cairo, visitors will visit the largest Egyptian museum, which houses over two hundred years old Egyptian artifacts from pre-dynastic times, the early age of the old, middle kingdoms, and new kingdoms, as well as the remains of renowned kings and queens. In Coptic Cairo, visitors can see the earliest Egyptian churches in history, including the Hanging Church of St. Mary, Church of St. Sergius, Cave Church, and Ben Ezra Synagogue. After a field visit and lunch, the tour concludes with lunch, breakfast, and transportation back to the hotel.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan

Transfer to Cairo International Airport and fly to Aswan. Meet your tour guide at the airport and board your 5-star Nile cruise boat before lunch. Enjoy the Nubian folkloric show and dinner before overnighting in Aswan.

Back to the Nile cruise to start your cruise to Kom Ombo; lunch will be served and then you will be accompanied by your guide for an extremely special sightseeing tour to the Temple of Kom Ombo which is worshipped to God Sobek. The Nile Cruise vessel will travel to Edfu with dinner on board and overnight accommodation on the vessel in Edfu.

Day 5: Edfu Temple

A buffet breakfast will be prepared for you on the Nile Cruise after that you are going to meet the tour guide for a sightseeing tour to the Temple of Edfu known as the Temple of Horus, containing some of the finest Ptolemaic architecture carved to honor the God Horus. There also it is possible to see a large granite statue of Horus that is placed in front of the entrance of the temple.

Sitting on its head is the protective Double Crown of Upper and Lower Egypt. once you are done going through all the details about Edfu then you will be back on Nile Cruise ship and then you will proceed to the final destination of the Egypt Nile Cruise tours which is Luxor. City Your lunch will be served on board and the afternoon tea. For the evening you expect high-quality dinner on the ship, after which you will delight in the traditional Galabya party.
